


JOINT PLATE (FOR MODELS HC-8/CC-8) INSTRUCTION MANUAL



This product is used when an additional "HOTCABI" HC-8 or "COOLCABI" CC-8 unit is to be stacked on top of a like unit to increase utilizable capacity. To use the product correctly and safely, please carefully read and fully understand the contents of this Instruction Manual prior to use.

Safety Precautions

- Precautionary measures referred to herein are matters which should be abided by for safe use and to prevent harm and/or damage being inflicted on yourself or others. Furthermore, the particulars of the precautionary measures have been classified into "Warning" and "Caution" to express the degree or extent of conceivable harm and damage which can be assumed to occur from mishandling. They are both of importance as far as safety is concerned and should be strictly abided by.
- Please keep this Instruction Manual together with the Instruction Manual regarding usage of HC-8 or CC-8 units after its contents have been understood.
- Please go over the above-mentioned Instruction Manual once again when this product is to be used.

⊘ Attention required for use	(1) Do not use this product for any purpose other than to stack another HC-8 or CC-8 on top of a like unit. Such could result in toppling or tumbling down.	⊘ Forbidden	(1) Do not place heavy items or water containers on top of "HOTCABI". Such could be the cause of toppling, tumbling down or failure.
⚠ Attention required for setting	(2) Install where the units can be horizontally and stably maintained at all times. If you do not, such could result in damage or tumbling down.	⊘ Forbidden	(2) Do not place heavy items on "HOTCABI" or place one's weight on it with its door open. Such could be the cause of damage or toppling.
⊘ Forbidden	(3) Always detach units when they are to be moved. If you do not, such could result in damage or tumbling down.		

How to Install and Use

- Place lower unit where it is to be installed and remove stains and dust from its top (Diagram 1).
* In case of stains on the top of the unit, wipe off with a tightly wrung slightly wet towel, etc.
- Peel off the two green-colored sheets attached to the back of the Joint Plate.
* Be careful not to touch the white-colored gummed surface.
- Attach to lower unit as indicated in Diagram 3.







- Peel off the two green-colored sheets on the face side, align position and place upper unit thereon as per Diagram 4.
* The two projections on the face side will slide into the slits on the bottom of the unit when properly and accurately placed.
* Be careful not to drop the unit when doing so.



- Press the places marked by a circle in Diagram 4 to ensure a snug fit.
* Wait at least 12 hours before using the units as completing adhesion takes time. Beginning use prior to that will make adhesive surface susceptible to separation.
* Press the places marked by a circle in Diagram 4, slightly sideways prior to use to ensure that units are securely bonded.
* Be careful not to accumulate too much water in the drain receptacle while units are being used.

HOW TO INSTALL AND REMOVE

- Lifting upper unit slightly sideways enables upper and lower unit separation.
* The Joint Plate can also be detached by lifting up sideways.
* Black-colored portions will remain on the units (2 on both upper and lower units).
- Refer to clauses 3. and 4. above when mounting and press places indicated by Diagram 4 firmly with the palm of your hands. Mounting is secure when a "click" sound is emitted.


